- The Tabletennis season will start in April 2026 and end in September 2026.
- There are 15 weeks of regular competition followed by 3 weeks of finals.
- There are 4 Senior Teams in the competition plus Juniors.
- Matches are also played against Jamestown and Whyalla during the year to be negotiated with the clubs.
- Membership fees and Subs are set for the season by the committee and are due and payable by the fourth match that any one player takes to the court (unless a payment plan has been negotiated with Club Treasurer).

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. - if you need clarification, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team - your team's performance will benefit — so will you.
- Be a good sport - applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Show respect to and acknowledge opponents and officials - (e.g. shake hands before and after the game and say things like 'good luck', 'thanks for the game',
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents - without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit - not just to please parents and coaches.
- Play fair — no verbal abuse or swearing , sledging other players (including vilification) or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants - regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Do not expect or accept "special" favours from a coach or person involved in team or club management.
- Speak to an someone else you trust if you have an issue, feel unsafe or are concerned about someone else.
